



The Educational Centre was inaugurated on 20 September 2007 and lies above the Jizera river valley in the historical centre of Mladá Boleslav. It forms the campus of the ŠKODA AUTO University, and several ŠKODA company departments are also located here.

The modern educational grounds have brought together new buildings and a historical church and monastery to form a unique architectural blend. This location has been dedicated to education since the 14th century and has remained loyal to this mission to this day.

The new building houses lecture rooms with state-of-the-art equipment, meeting rooms, and two conference rooms which may be linked together to form a large lecture hall. Along with standard and specially-equipped lecture rooms, the Centre also offers a multimedia study room and a library, and has its own cafeteria.

The ŠKODA AUTO University is the first university in the Czech Republic founded by a private company. It offers part-time or full-time bachelor and master degree programmes with an emphasis on economic studies and management. As part of their practical training, students are offered internships at ŠKODA AUTO as well as within the whole VW Group.

The Educational Centre Na Karmeli is a place where the past and future meet at one point. This theme is further developed by a monumental time line spanning from 2,000 B.C. up until the present day, and encompasses world history and the history of Bohemia, including Mladá Boleslav and the car maker.
