14. 5. – RADKA FIŠAROVÁ & SAŠA YASINSKI & JAZZ4

The third concert from the Chanson cycle, a Song with a Story. Radka Fišarová is coming to the ŠKODA Museum with the Czech-French concert programme Rendez-vous. You will hear not only French chansons by leading French performers (E. Piaf, Ch. Aznavour, M. Mathieu, etc.) but also famous film melodies and songs in unusual arrangements. A large part of the repertoire consists of the Czech author's songs and chansons from the new CD Rendez-vous. 18. 5. – THE MUSEUM NIGHT AT THE ŠKODA MUZEUM

ŠKODA Museum, as every year, will take part in the Mladá Boleslav Museum Night. You can look forward to the traditional night tours of ŠKODA AUTO's production plants from 19:00 and 20:30 (registration required from 18:00 in the vestibule of the museum for visitors over 10 years old). During the tour, visitors will see two production halls. The permanent exhibition of the museum and the depository of ŠKODA prototypes and sport cars will be freely accessible, too. At the Laurin & Klement Forum, representatives of the ŠKODA SUV segment will be presented. Visitors will not only be able to see the latest models of ŠKODA – KODIAQ and KAROQ cars in detail, but will also be able to get in touch with them. The crystalline design of ŠKODA cars in practice will be seen in the PRECIOSA brushing workshop and the car presentation will be accompanied by acrobatic performances. A children's corner, workshop, and art workshop will be prepared for children, where they will be able to colour and get a KODIAQ small backpack. In good weather, children and adults will be able to ride their pedal cars in the parking lot in front of the museum, where they will again see an exhibition of selected historic cars from the museum's collection.

Visitors to the Mladá Boleslav Museum Night can take the historical buses ŠKODA 706 RO and ŠKODA 706 RTO along the track ŠKODA Museum – Old Town Square – Metoděj Vlach Aircraft Museum and in the opposite direction in half-hour intervals from 19:00 to 23:30. 18. 5. – THE MUSEUM NIGHT UNDER JEŠTĚD IN F. PORSCHE'S BIRTH HOUSE IN VRATISLAVICE

The five-hour programme will begin at 18:00 and the visitors will be introduced to the impressive life of the famous automobile engineer and pioneer of electromobility, Ferdinand Porsche. The guided tours of the expositions will remind that the enthusiasm for technology, engineering and mechanical engineering has a rich tradition in the Czech Republic. The youngest visitors certainly should not miss a children's workshop. The Birth House Café has prepared wine degustation and stylish refreshments from the time of the First Republic. Free admission, from 18:00 to 23:00.

22. 5. – DAN BÁRTA & ILLUSTRATOSPHERE: MEZI VRCHOLY (AMONG THE PEAKS) TOUR 2018

Dan Bárta, the 11-time holder of the Anděl Prize in the categories Singer of the Year and Quarter Century Singer, gained global acclaim during the 1990s with Alice band and appearing in the musical Jesus Christ Superstar. He also became an inherent part of the J.A.R. band. In 2000, he surprised fans with his own band Illustratosphere, with which he is currently preparing his fifth album. The album selection will be presented in arrangement with internationally renowned drummer, Martin Valihora on the 2018 tour "Mezi vrcholy". An unmistakable voice with excellent technique, first-class musicians and songs flying over the

domestic standard of popular music. Dan Bárta & Illustratosphere have been enchanting listeners across generations and musical genres for nineteen years! L&K Forum, from 20:00, to sit in places. Entrance fee: CZK 380.

HISTORY OF L&K AND ŠKODA ADVERTISING: FROM THE SUPERB BICYCLE TO THE SUPERB CAR

Join us to look into the styles, techniques and design of advertising materials associated with the brands LAURIN & KLEMENT and ŠKODA in their individual phases of development: From the first, manually printed ads for the sale of bicycles and motorcycles through the promotional flyers and booklets for individual cars to the complete products and image campaigns. The history of promoting the ŠKODA AUTO brand is as rich as the history of the company itself. The exhibition offers a unique look into the Czech carmaker's communication strategy over time and in the context of the corresponding period. Exhibition open till 21st June.

DAVID ČERNÝ: CZECH BETHLEHEM

The unique exhibition of bronze sculptures by the artist David Černý presents scenes of Czech history and culture. The detailed elaboration of individual figurines resembles the traditional nativity scene. The set of sculptures was created for the Autostadt (Wolfsburg, Germany) on the occasion of EXPO 2000. The Czech artist David Černý is famous for creating figurative sculptures for public spaces. He studied design and sculpture at the Academy of Arts, Architecture & Design in Prague and is a prize-winner of the Jindřich Chalupecký Award. His work includes the Pink Tank, the Babies on the Žižkov TV Tower and the Entropa.

All current exhibitions are covered in the regular museum entrance fee. Take the opportunity to buy the year-round tickets for the ŠKODA Museum exhibitions for a reduced price of CZK 280.

STANDING EXHIBITION

The exhibition is divided into three thematic sections – Tradition, Evolution and Precision. The section “Tradition” reflects ŠKODA's brand values – Pride, Everyday usability and Challenges – represented by three pairs of vehicles. The section “Evolution” begins with the busts of the two founders. It is characterized by a timeline of milestones in automotive development. The section “Precision” illustrates cars in different stages of renovation – from the stage of finding the vehicle to producing a “jewel”. The process of contemporary car production can be seen in our panoramic cinema.

EXHIBITION AND FACTORY TOURS

We offer guided tours of the ŠKODA Museum and the ŠKODA AUTO factory. We also provide tours of the Lean Centre, ŠKODA Parts Centre, Educational Centre Na Karmeli and the **production plant in Vrchlabí and Kvasiny**. FERDINAND PORSCHE BIRTH HOUSE

We invite you to explore the newly renovated house where Ferdinand Porsche – car designer and creator of the Volkswagen car – was born in 1875. The authentic place presents key moments in the history of engineering and construction craftsmanship, including Ferdinand Porsche's lifework. It is possible to view the exhibition individually with iPads borrowed on-site.

For groups of over 20 people, we recommend contacting us in advance. Before or after the exhibition tour, visitors to the museum can purchase refreshments in the VÁCLAV Café Restaurant, and there is also a small shop.
