FIRST KILOMETRES IN THE FIRST REPUBLIC

100 years since the founding of the Czech Republic

We would like to invite you for a ride across the first republic! At the time the Mladá Boleslav car maker L&K / ŠKODA we among the pillars of the motorsport boom in Masaryk's Czechoslovakia. What did our forefathers learn in driving lessons? How did they manage without navigation? What were the speed limits at the time? Where did you refuel, park or go to a service garage? Come to discover the exciting world of motorsport, exotic long-distance rides or VIP ŠKODA owners and much more at a new exhibition, which will be open for public from 23 October 2018 to April 2019.

DAVID ČERNÝ: CZECH BETHLEHEM

The unique exhibition of bronze sculptures by the artist David Černý presents scenes of Czech history and culture. The detailed elaboration of individual figurines resembles the traditional nativity scene. The set of sculptures was created for the Autostadt (Wolfsburg, Germany) on the occasion of EXPO 2000. The Czech artist David Černý is famous for creating figurative sculptures for public spaces. His work includes the Pink Tank, the Babies on the Žižkov TV Tower and the Entropa. PERMANENT EXHIBITION

The exhibition is divided into three thematic sections – Tradition, Evolution and Precision. The section "Tradition" reflects ŠKODA's brand values – Pride, Everyday usability and Challenges – represented by three pairs of vehicles. The section "Evolution" begins with the busts of the two founders. It is characterized by a timeline of milestones in automotive development. The section "Precision" illustrates cars in different stages of renovation – from the stage of finding the vehicle to producing a "jewel". The process of contemporary car production can be seen in our panoramic cinema.
